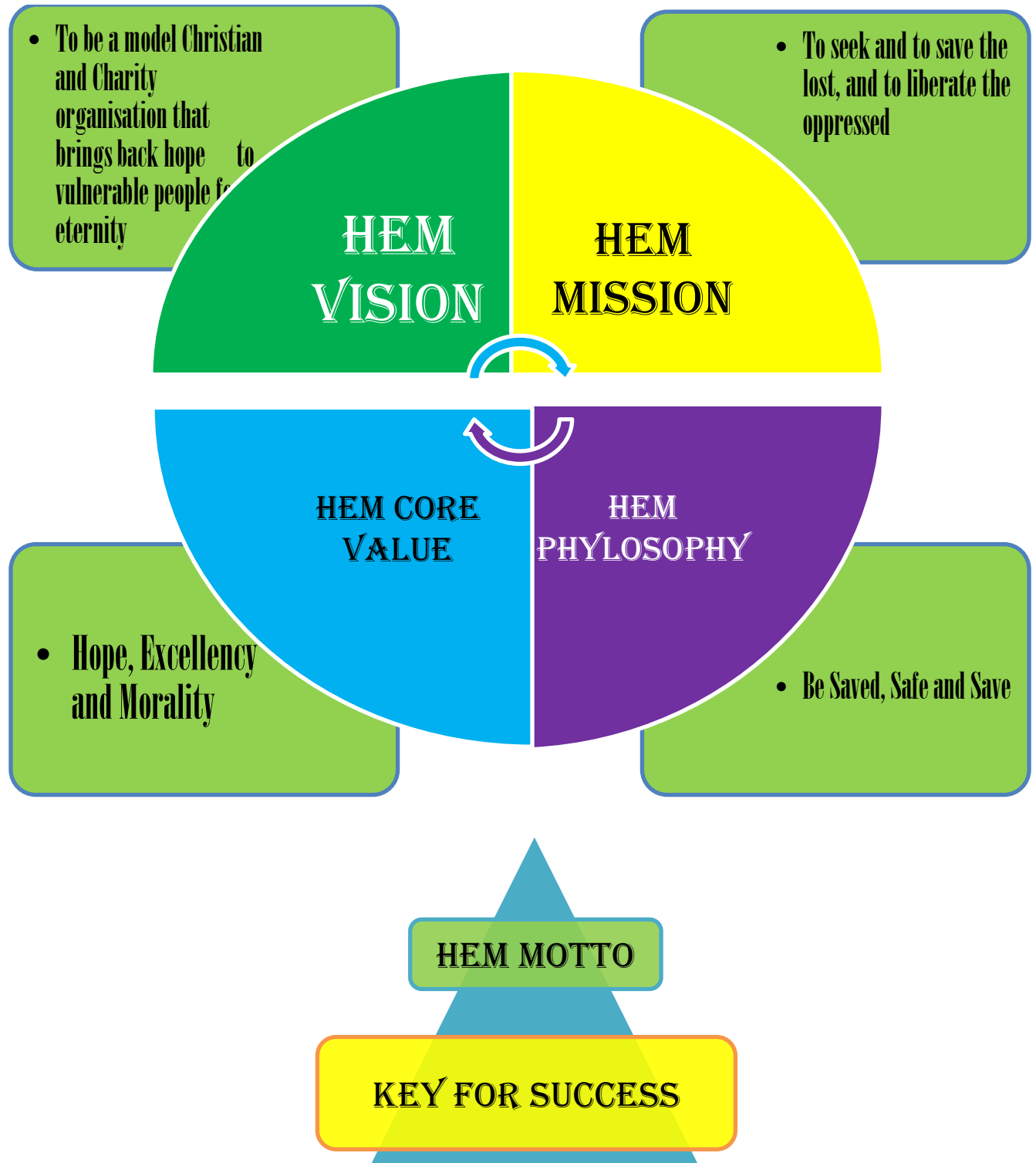

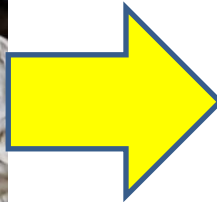

4.1. Realization in Kyaka II Refugee settlement

KYAKA II

4.1.1. Orphans' care and Support

In February 2021, HEM did excellent work caring for 116 vulnerable children. Among them we have 34 total orphans and 82 orphans were supported in Kyaka II Refugee Settlement. They have been given milk, porridge, food, clothing and some health care.

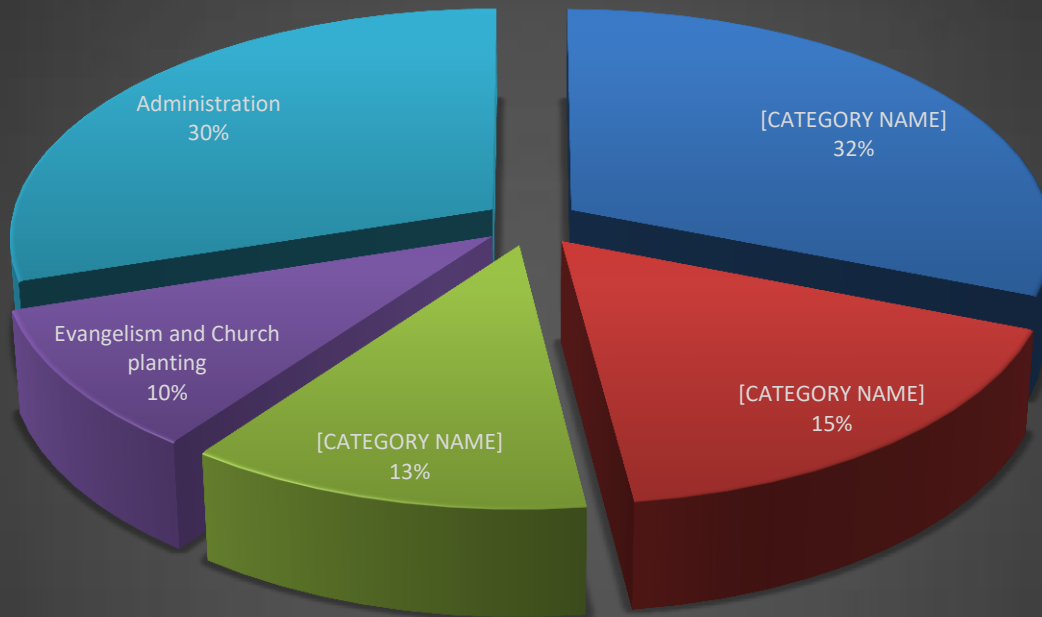
