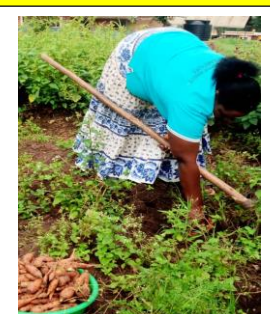

May God bless you all!

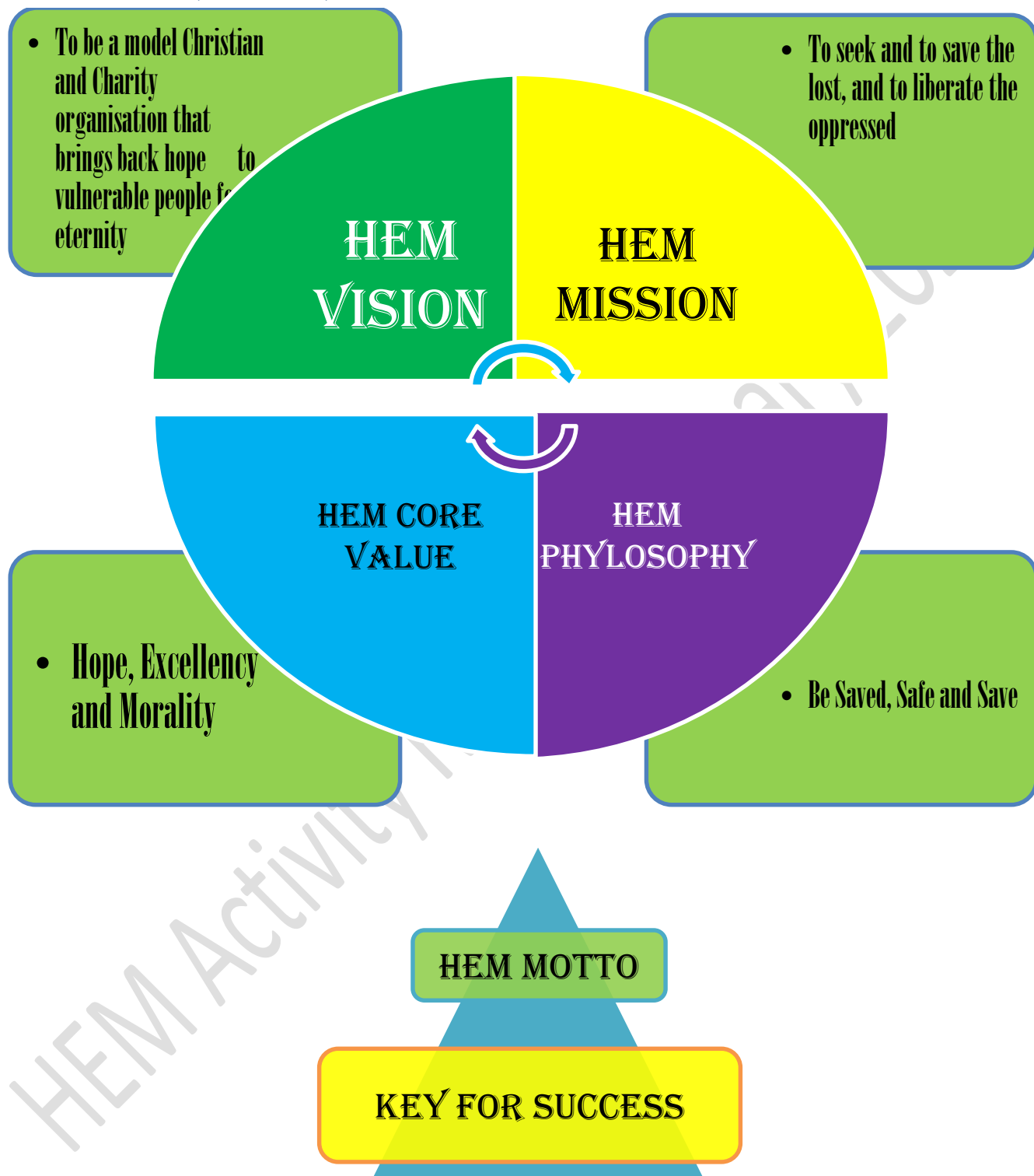

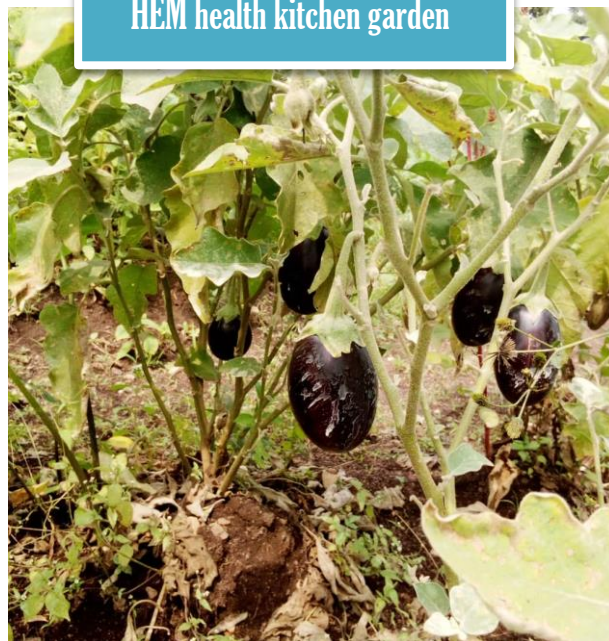

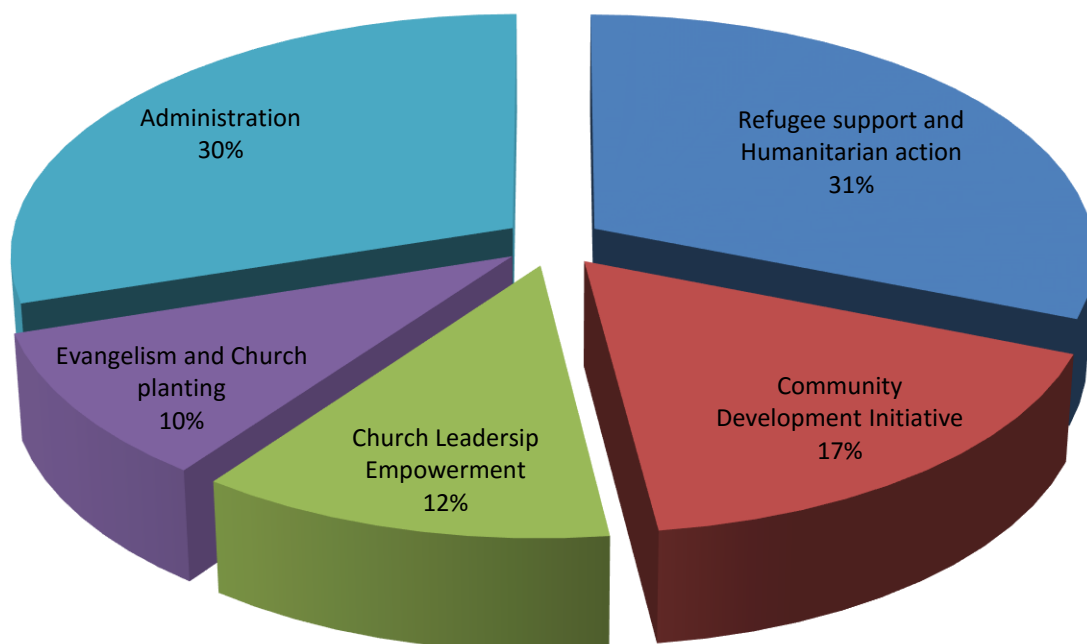
