May God bless all of you.





4.1.1. Orphans' care and Support to vulnerable people

In Kyaka II, we are supporting 280 vulnerable children. Primarily 84 were supported in May 2021: (23 total orphans, 61 partial orphans). We supported also 42 elderly among others. The support given was: cow milk, powder milk, porridge, fruits, food, health care etc. We appreciate so much our donors, staff and beneficiaries.




In May 2021, HEM Nakivale supported 106 orphans (26 total orphans, 24 partial orphans, 56 other vulnerable children) and 14 elderly.






